About the Tails of Independence Virtual Fundraising Campaign

What is the Tails of Independence Virtual Fundraising Campaign?

Tails of Independence is a month-long virtual fundraising campaign benefitting Can Do Canines. Information about this virtual fundraising campaign can be found at <u>can-do.link/toi</u>. When is the Tails of Independence Virtual Fundraising Campaign?

The virtual fundraising campaign runs April 11-May 11 with the finale shown on May 11 at 7:00pm CST

What does the Tails of Independence Virtual Fundraising Campaign support?

Tails of Independence directly supports Can Do Canines' work to create life-changing partnerships between dogs and people living with disabilities. Donations help pay for veterinary care, dog food and treats, support for our puppy raiser volunteer program, instruction in Can Do Canines' prison puppy raising program, advanced training for dogs, client matching, and much more.

When can people start donating to the Tails of Independence Virtual Fundraising Campaign?

People can start donating now through May 11, 2021. Late donations are okay, too – we will keep the campaign open at least a week for the mail-in gifts or additional online gifts.

What if someone wants to mail their gift?

Gifts can be mailed to: Can Do Canines, 9440 Science Center Drive, New Hope, MN 55428. Please indicate the gift is for the Tails of Independence Virtual Fundraising Campaign and if the gift is connected to a Virtual Host (by name).

What is a Virtual Host?

Can Do Canines Virtual Hosts help spread the word about the Tails of Independence Virtual Fundraising Campaign and Can Do Canines' work by setting up a fundraiser page at can-do.link/toi and sharing it with their friends, family, colleagues, and community contacts.

What are the mini-events in April and finale program on Tuesday, May 11?

Can Do Canines is hosting Tails of Independence mini-events throughout April, such as virtual puppy training, a virtual tour of our state of the art training facility in New Hope, MN and other events as they are confirmed. On Tuesday, May 11 at 7:00pm CST, the Tails of Independence Virtual Fundraising Campaign will culminate with a finale program. You will get the chance to hear inspiring testimonials from our clients, meet some of Can Do Canines' newest puppies, get the latest update from Can Do Canines' Executive Director, and more.

When should I sign up to become a Virtual Host?

We recommend signing up as soon as you can. Ideally, you will reach out to your contacts several times over the course of a few weeks during the fundraising campaign.

How to be a Virtual Host

1) Sign up as a Can Do Canines Virtual Host on this website and click "Become a Can Do Canines Virtual Host":

Note: If you were a 2020 Virtual Host for the Tails of Independence Virtual Event, you do not have to sign-up again. Instead, click "Login" at the top right of <u>can-do.link/toi</u> or the "Log in" button on the "Become a Can Do Canines Virtual Host" page.

- 2) Decide on whom and how you will reach out to about the Tails of Independence Virtual Fundraising Campaign and your "personal fundraiser page". People to reach out to include family, friends, colleagues, business and community contacts – anyone who may be inspired to support our mission.
- 3) Reach out to your community and share your personal fundraiser page. We recommend reaching out 2-3 times over the course of the fundraising campaign, with the purpose of:
 - Contact #1: Inform people about the Tails of Independence Virtual Fundraising Campaign and invite people to support you in reaching your fundraising goal.
 - Contact #2: Remind people about the Tails of Independence Virtual Fundraising Campaign and your "personal fundraiser page".
 - Contact #3: Encourage people to tune in to the finale program on May 11, 2021 at 7:00pm CST.
- 4) Thank people as they donate to your campaign. This can be done through an email, phone call, etc.
 - Recommended: Within one week after the fundraiser ends on May 11, send an update/final
 thank you email to everyone who donated to support your fundraising goal. This is a great
 time to share how much money was raised in total for Can Do Canines Tails of
 Independence Virtual Fundraising Campaign. You can also send a personal thank you note.
 Thank you cards will be provided.
- 5) Note: To view a list of donations to your fundraiser, change your profile picture, publish updates on your page about your personal fundraiser or the greater Tails of Independence Virtual Fundraising Campaign, or edit various aspects of your account: Make sure you are signed into CauseVox and access this information through your "dashboard." To go to your dashboard, click your profile photo at the top right of your personal fundraiser page (or on Can Do Canines' main CauseVox website can-do.link/toi.
- 6) We have provided optional messaging templates for your use on the following pages.
- 7) Optional: Publish updates on your "personal fundraiser page". These updates can be about progress towards reaching your fundraising goal, the greater Tails of Independence Virtual Fundraising Campaign, etc.
- 8) Tune in for the Can Do Canines' finale program on May 11 at 7:00pm CST.

I'm participating in a virtual fundraising campaign called Tails of Independence and it benefits one of my favorite nonprofits, Can Do Canines. I wanted to invite you to learn more about this impactful organization, and to support me in reaching my fundraising goal. [Why Can Do Canines' cause is important to you.]

Can Do Canines creates life-changing partnerships by providing highly-skilled assistance dogs for people living with disabilities. One of the most inspiring Can Do Canines stories is about a young boy named Draven and his Autism Assist Dog Ginny.

Draven lives with his mother, Katie; twin sister, Willow; older brother, Drake; and pet cats. Draven also lives with Autism Spectrum Disorder, as well as various other conditions that affect his ability to self-regulate and communicate. Katie has watched Draven self-initiate tasks and become more confidently independent since he is becoming aware of his own needs. He is acknowledging his own triggering situations and seeking Ginny for solace. "She helps keep him grounded and for longer periods of time. His outbursts are a lot shorter now," Katie explains. This benefits the whole family since the situation can be navigated quickly. Ginny has helped ease Draven's emotions and is truly a conduit in his sibling relationships, even as a social bridge when Draven plays with Ginny and his siblings. Draven has flourished with the routines and responsibilities that Ginny requires, and every single member of the family has found a new level of thriving, thanks to Ginny. Seeing a light shining on their future is one of Katie's greatest joys because of this extraordinary assistance dog. "The family feels full. It feels whole again."
